

## Example Equipment

### 1. Example Tablet

#### Windows Tablet 12" or 10"

Needs to be able to run Windows OS not mobile version. Ruggedised cases can be bought for surface devices if required. If it is being secured to the trolley then you may not need a case.



The cost for a good Windows Tablet can range from £500 to £4000 it depends if you need swappable batteries etc.

### 2. Example Fixing Kit to attach to Trolley option



A 10" Tablet with the above fixing kit is an easy solution. Cost £20
